The Montana Association of Language Teachers (MALT) strives to recruit new members by offering a scholarship program for 2 new members each year. The successful candidates will receive the following: a 2-year membership to the organization, one free conference registration, and a small stipend to pay for a shared hotel room for the two successful candidates. Two conferences are held each year, one that coincides with the MEA-MFT convention in October, and the 2nd conference is generally the 2nd week of April. All conferences have a key-note presenter, who is generally recognized as an expert in at least one aspect of teaching a World Language. Conferences also allow the opportunity to work as a Professional Learning Community by sharing best practices and discussing pedagogy in a supportive environment.
